Saves Little Town





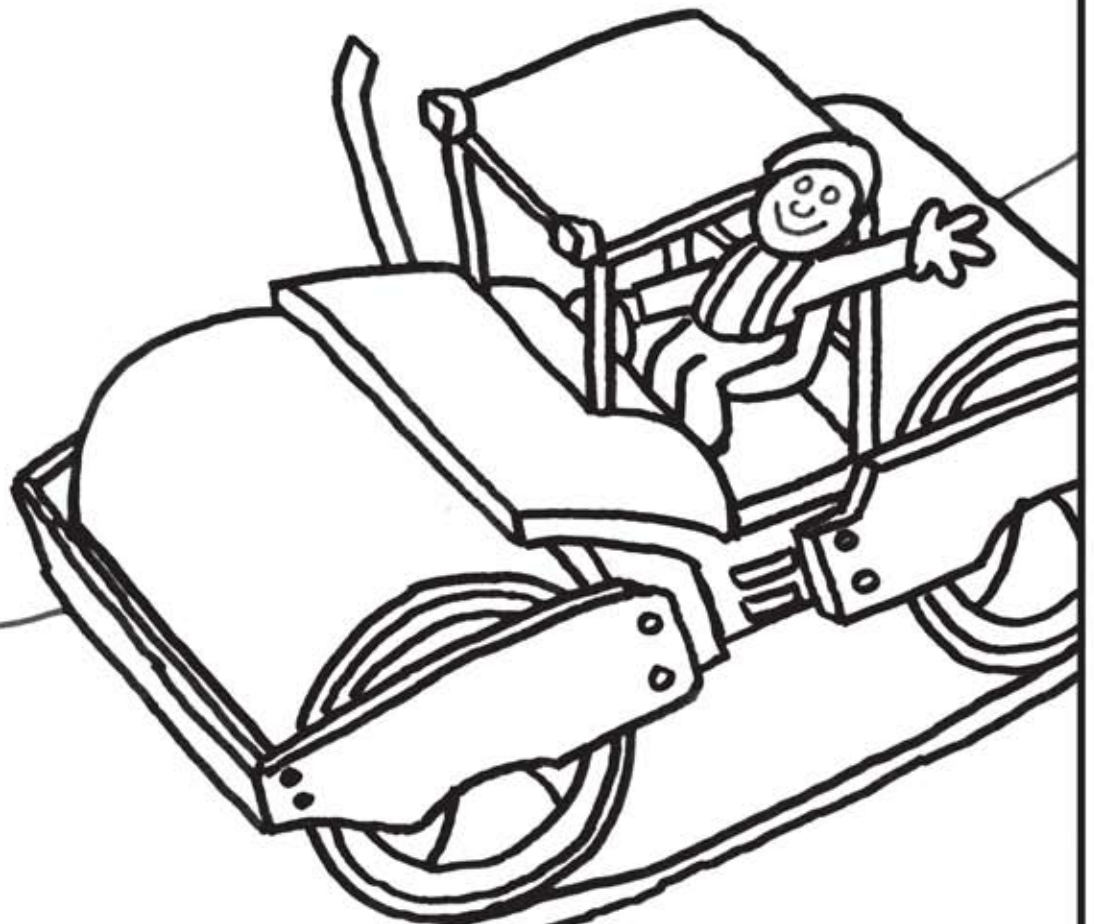

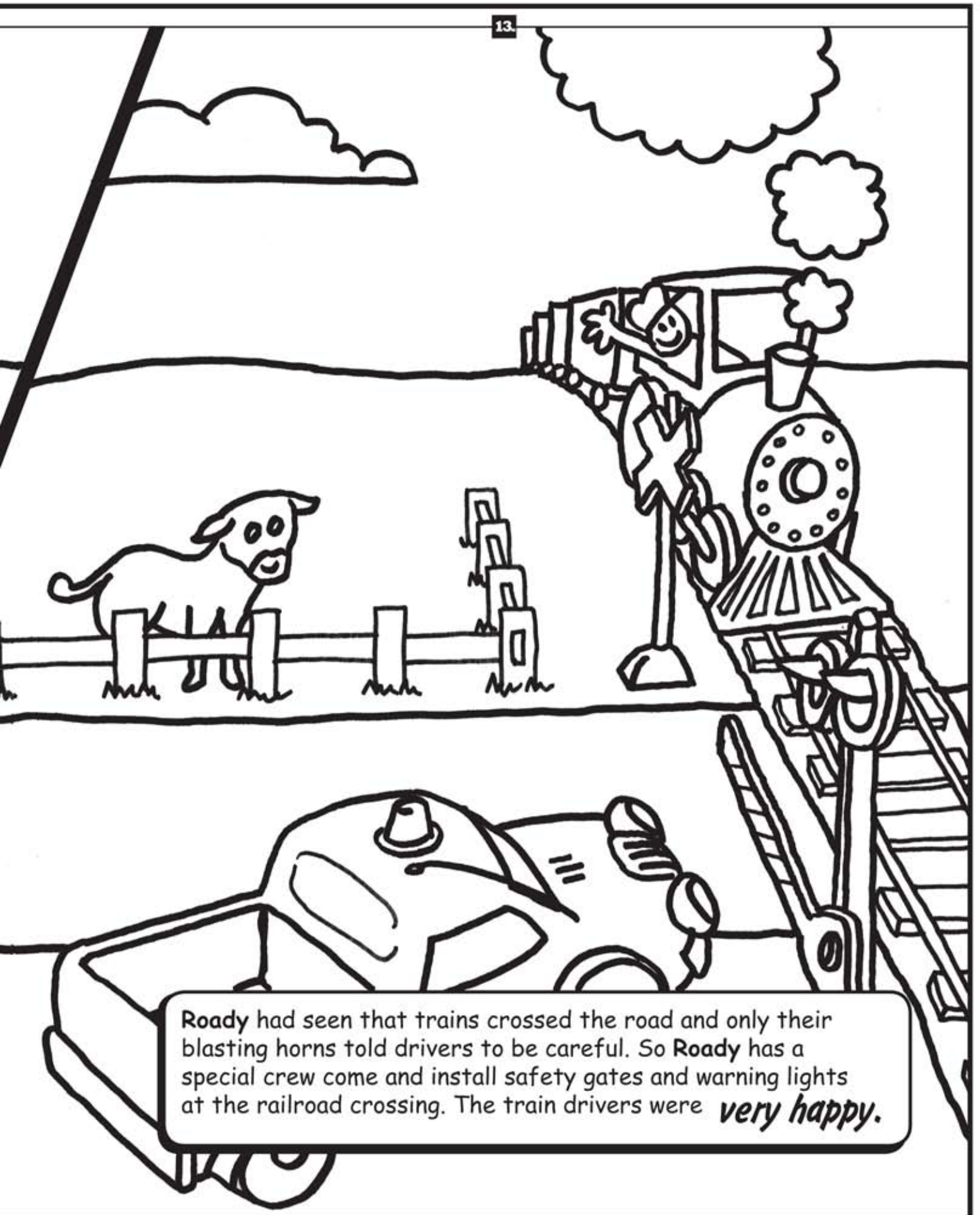
